Discussed the Martindale's request for a water tap. They were present at the September meeting. Discussed Lawrence Zeldenthuis purchasing a water tap from Larry Allen. That tap would be installed in the spring and would be located on Grandview Mesa next to Lubin's property.

Discussed the backflow preventers that are on the yoke of our new meters. All the new meters are in now with these yokes. Discussed what the future might present with backflow preventers. The flow meter at Cottonwood/Crawford Road intersection was installed this last month.
