Gary Hubbell asked what the Board's position would be if CMWA started having Marijuana grow houses using the domestic water for watering plants. Currently there is a 20,000 gallon limit on the amount of water that can be used. The only time a member has gone over this amount in the last year is due to leaks. If this occurred not due to a leak, the member would be informed of the limit and if it continued to happen they would be subject to shut off.

Terms for Lynn French, Tracy Cheatham and Joanie Cherp are up this year. By vote and proclamation Lynn, Tracy and Joanie will serve on the Board.
