The financial report was given. The checking account has \$138.63, the Money Market account has \$4,671.95, second Money Market \$100,145.02 and the 1-year CD has \$47,336.45. The Hotchkiss CD has \$5,582.25.

Bills presented were DMEA \$31.69, Master Petroleum \$174.65, Clifford Industries \$1,620.00, TDS \$44.94, Bolinger & Queen \$2,357.13, Hellman Motors \$49.84, Gambles \$52.47 and Verizon \$104.04. Joanie moved and Dave seconded to pay the bills. The motion passed.

Lynn talked with the insurance company regarding the liability of the mangers using their own plane to read the meters. They said it would not be necessary to draw up a contract between Adam and the Company.

The testing is all done on the Hamilton Springs. The MPA's came back fine and the bacti's showed absent coliform/absent E. coli for the first and last months of testing. The rest of the months were absent E. coli and some were present coliform. The conductivity was constant threw out the testing. Everything has been submitted to the State to be determined the fate of the Hamilton Springs.

Tiger Electric bid for the installation of the electric to the top of the airport tanks was \$4,950.00. Lynn moved to accept the bid from Tiger Electric. Mark seconded and the motion passed.

Discussed the pressure on Linman Lane. A new regulator has been installed on the line.

Discussed overages over the 20,000 maximum usage allowed. Lynn moved that effective immediately the rates for gallons used over 20,000 will be doubled. Mark seconded and the motion passed. Marici will send this notice out on the next billing and have Tracy change the website.
